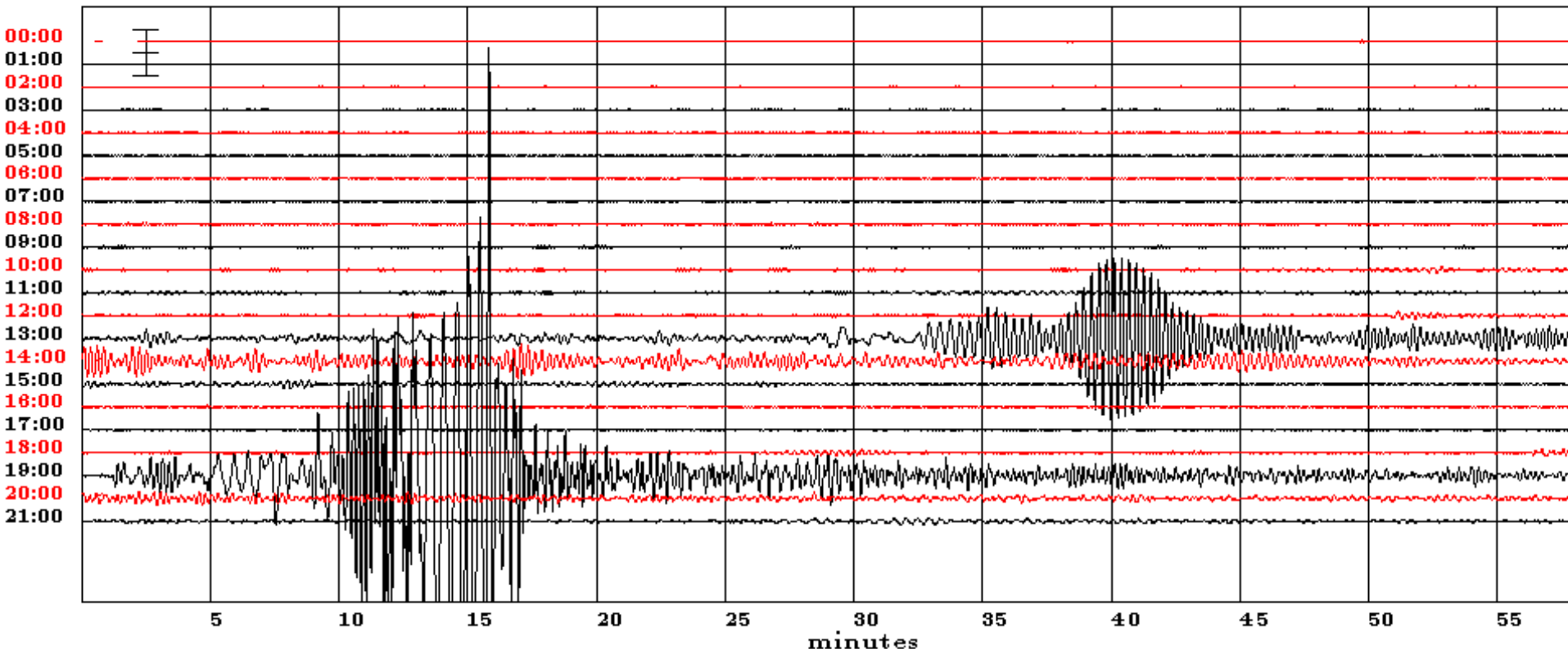


GMT 2 micrometer/s Station PAL, channel LPZ - Feb 28, 2001

Quake jolts the Pacific Northwest

A magnitude-6.8 earthquake struck the Northwest on Wednesday. Its epicenter was northeast of Olympia, Wash. The quake was felt across the region and into Canada.

The 6.8-magnitude earthquake, centered about 35 miles southwest of Seattle, was felt Wednesday as far away as southern Oregon and Canada. But of the 250 injuries directly linked to the quake, all but a few were minor and none was considered critical.
